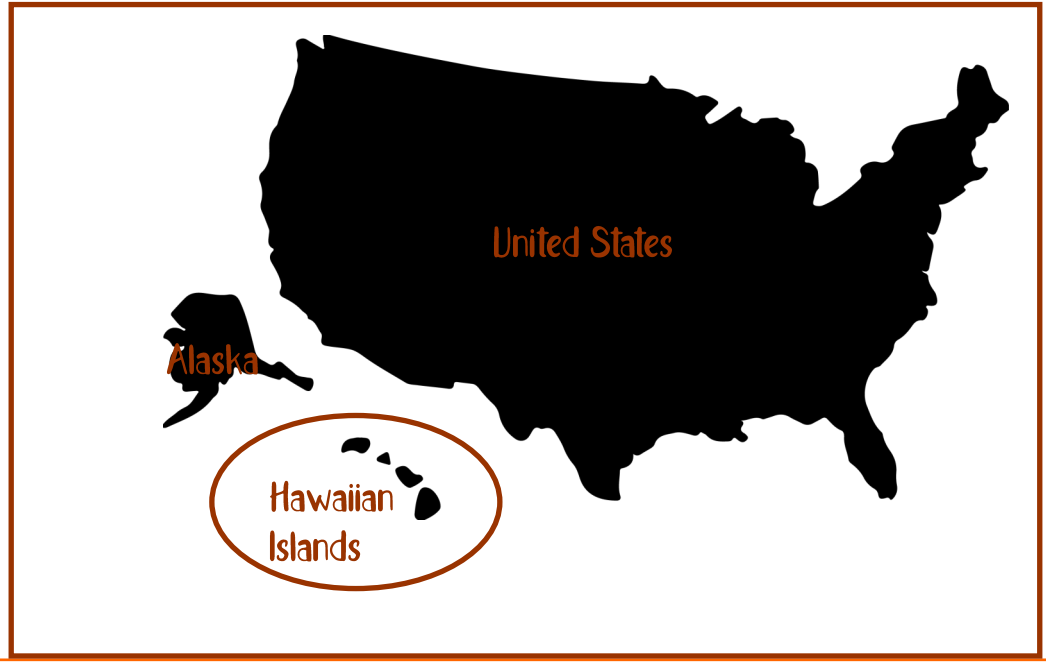
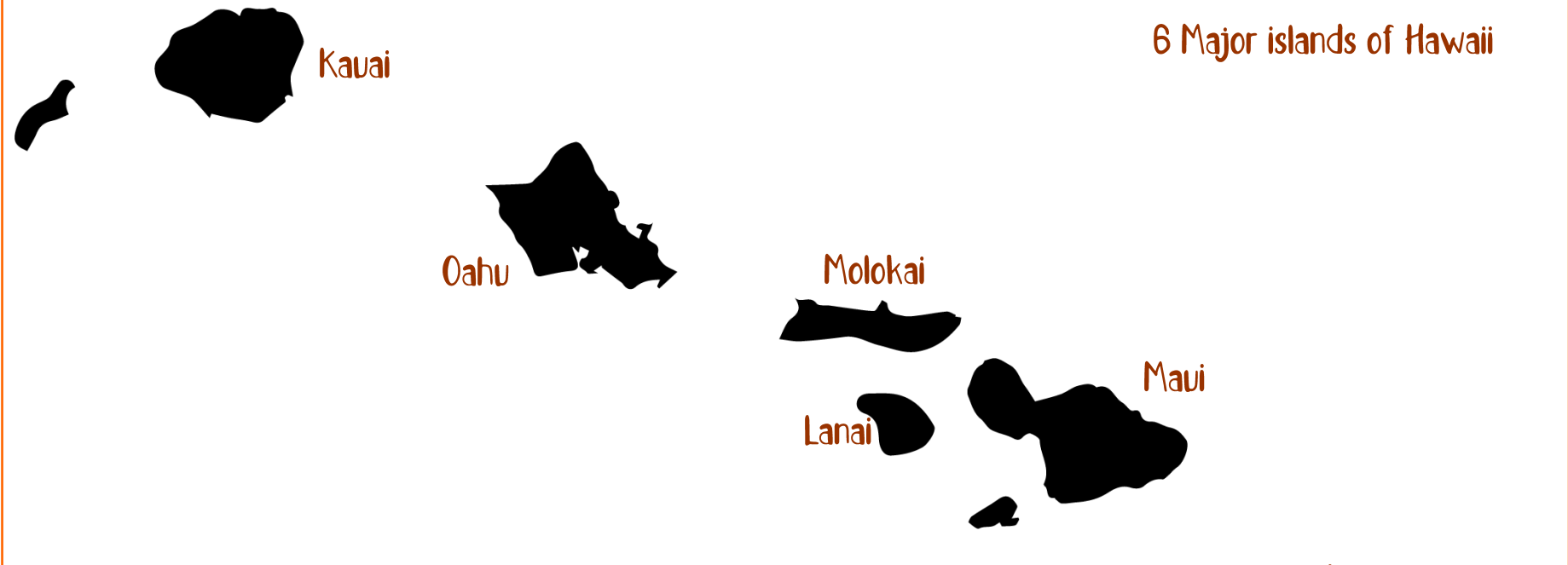
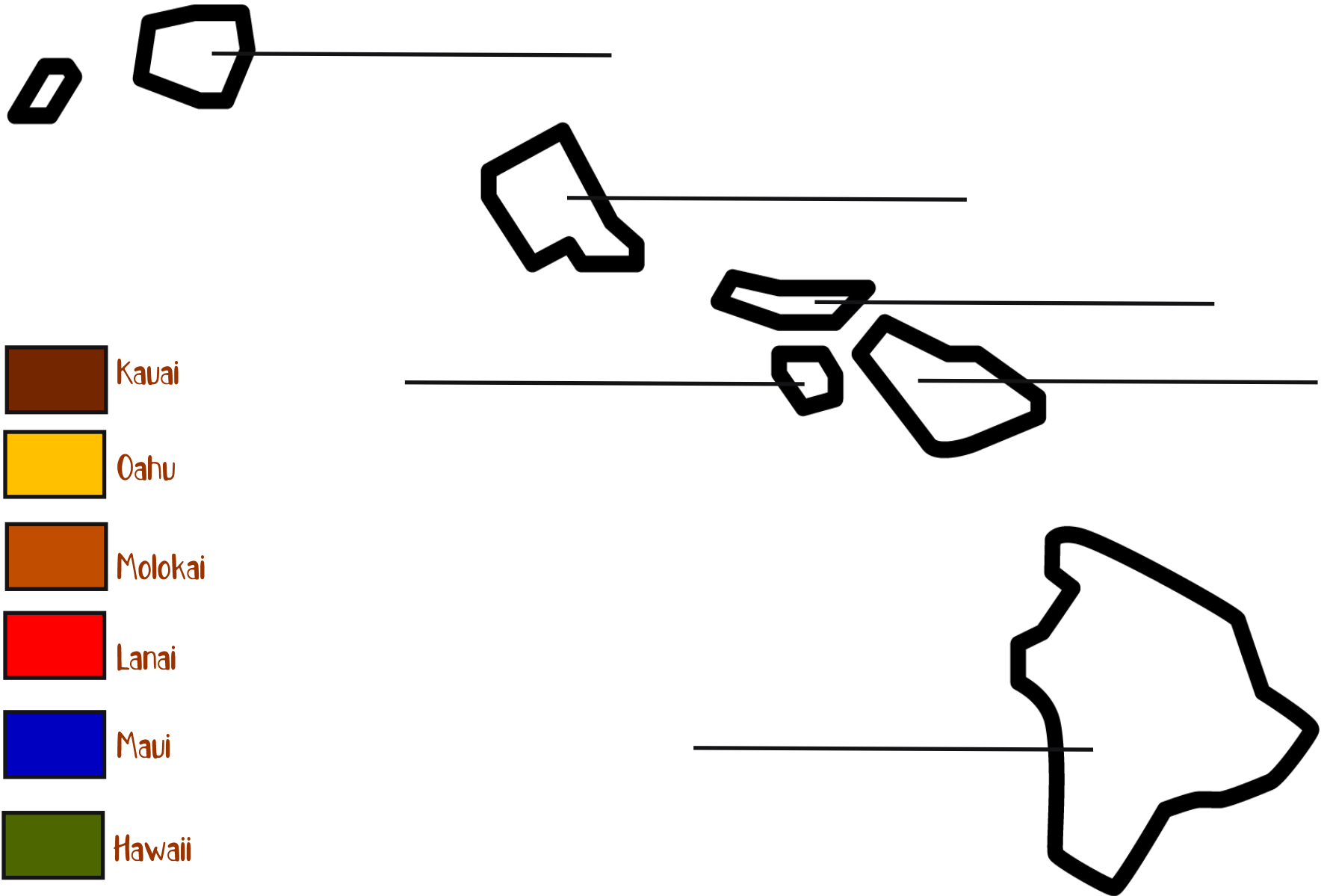


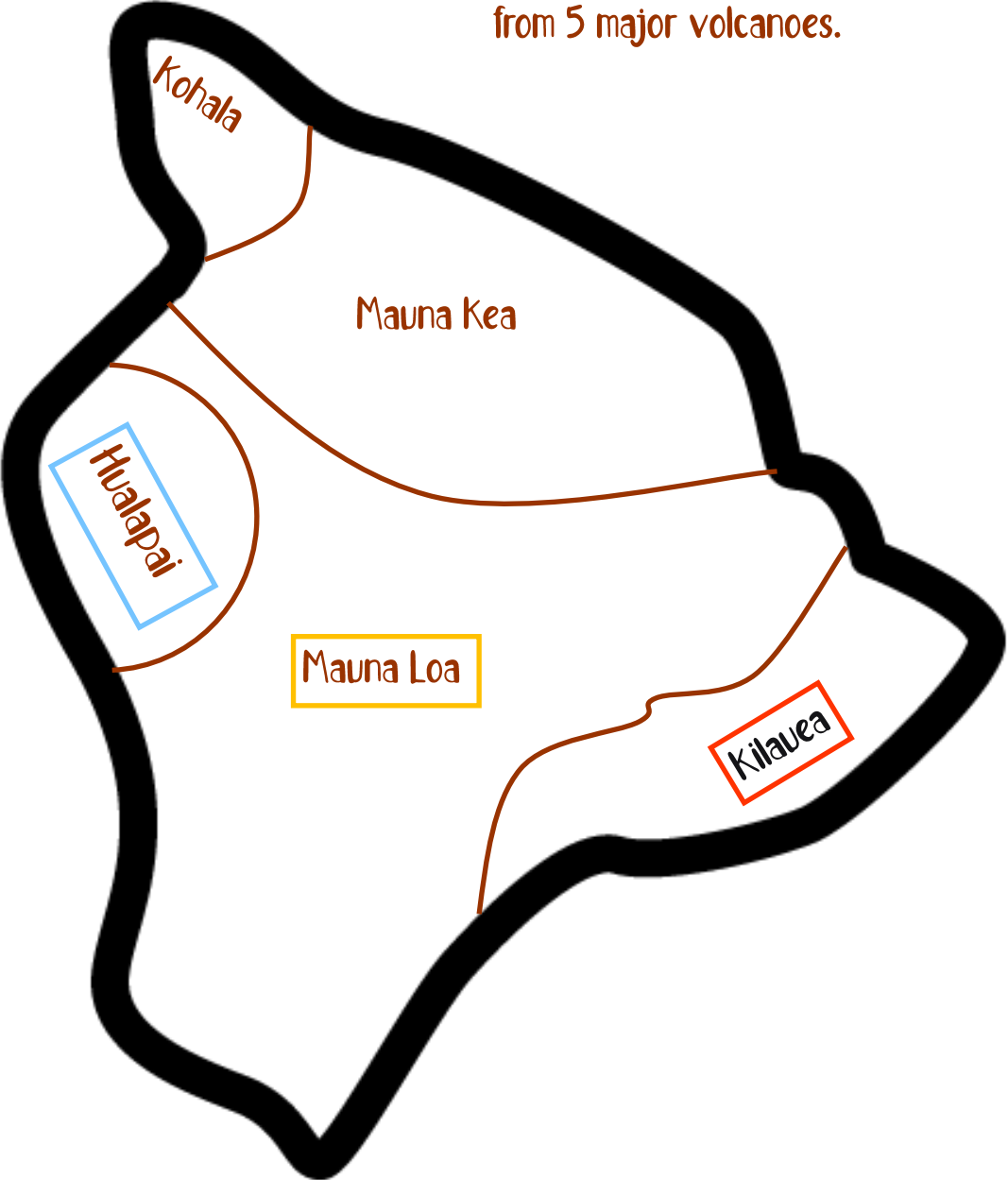
6 Major islands of Hawaii

## Kilauea

The Kilauea volcano erupted in December, 2020. There was water for the first time in the volcano, and when it mixed with lava, it caused explosive reactions. In 2018, the lava ran down the volcano and ruined homes that were built near by. In 2020, the lava stayed mostly in the crater on the inside. Fumes from the volcano are unhealthy to breath, even if the lava stays on the inside.

## Color the Volcanoes

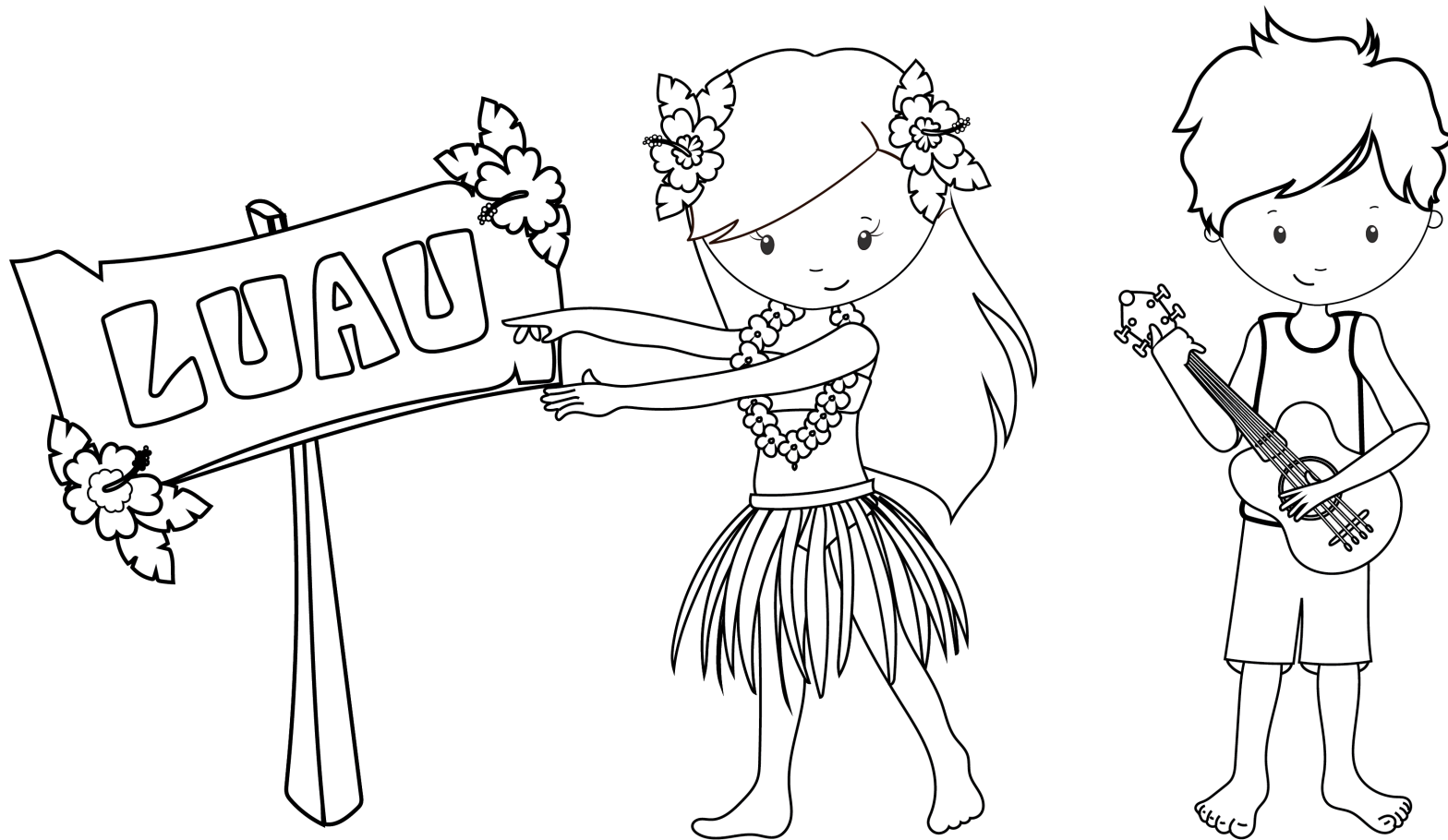
Mauna Loa and Kilauea volcanoes are both shield volcanoes. Mauna Loa is a much older volcano than Kilauea. Kilauea sits on the edge of Mauna Loa, and Mauna Loa is a very long volcano. The volcanoes of Hawaii created Hawaii, and their eruptions continue to change the shape of this island.



Tiki statues were first carved to represent gods. People still include tiki figures in traditional ceremonies. Today, some people believe having tikis in their homes keeps away bad things.



Visitors to Hawaii usually attend a Luau. Luau means "gathering meal". A luau usually includes pork that was cooked under the ground, and coconut pudding. Often, there is cultural entertainment provided by dancers and others for visitors.



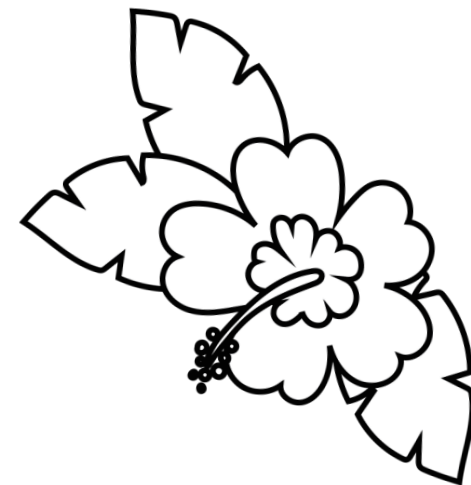
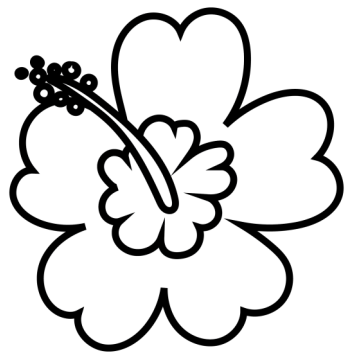
The yellow Hibiscus is the State flower of Hawaii. There are different kinds of Hibiscus flowers that grow on Hawaii. The hibiscus flower and other flowers are used to make a lei, a flower necklace. The Lei was originally used many years ago as a gift of friendship, or for celebrations. Now, a lei is given to tourists who visit Hawaii, to welcome people as guests.
